- 1. Are you more of a worker or a talker? Do you find more satisfaction in getting the job done or connecting with other people?
- 2. Why do you think non-Christian people are turned off by Christians?

- 3. What does the "life of the age to come" look like?
- 4. Why did Jesus choose a despised Samaritan to be the hero of the story? What does that say about how we should live as kingdom citizens?
- 5. Think about people of a different race, a different socio-economic class, or a person with different political opinions. What can you do to show mercy to them?
- 6. Why do we struggle to put into practice the teachings of Jesus?
- 7. Pastor Derek said, "Our life in pursuit of Jesus is not primarily about theology (*what we believe*), liturgy (*the shape of our worship*), or piety (*our heart's devotion*), but a way of living shaped by the Holy Spirit around the death and resurrection of Jesus." What value is theology, liturgy, or piety if we don't actually live what we believe?
