6. Søren Kierkegaard wrote, "*Christ was crucified because he would have nothing to do with the crowd (even though he addressed himself to all). He did not want to form a party, an interest group, a mass movement, but he wanted to be what he was, the truth, which is related to the single individual. The crowd is untruth.*" In what way is "the crowd" untruth?
7. What do we mean when we say "Jesus is salvation"?
8. What does it look like for you to spend time with Jesus?
9. Zacchaeus was on his way to become someone he was not. He was lost. Who are we supposed to be?
10. Who do you know that is lost and in need of a visit from Jesus? What can you do to extend an invitation from Jesus to this person?
