- 2. Are you more naturally a fighter, a lover, or some combination of the two?

Read Genesis 32:22-31

- 3. In what ways was Jacob successful, sensible, logical, practical, and responsible leading up to this experience with God?
- 4. What does Jacob's all-night wrestling match reveal to us about the life of faith for followers of Jesus?
- 5. Jacob, which means "heel grabber," had his name changed to Israel, meaning "wrestles with God." How does a name change work to change one's identity? How did this change of identity affect Jacob and the nation of Israel to come after him?
- 6. Who or what besides God has the power to shape our identity? How does that compare to the identity we find in Christ?
- 7. Have you ever wrestled with God regarding a situation, an issue, a decision, or a certain doctrine? If so, what was that experience like?
- 8. Wrestling with God like Jacob requires us to wait like waiting for the stars to appear on a cloudless night. What do you do while you wait for God to show up or answer or reveal himself?
- 9. What can we do to reject the false names spoken over us? How do we reject those false identities that keep us from being our true selves?
- 10. What is one thing you can do to remind yourself on a regular basis who you are in Christ?
