3. What benefits would Moses have experienced as the Son of Pharaoh's daughter?
4. What was the experience of the people of God in Egypt?
5. Why would the writer of the Hebrews say "He (Moses) thought it was better to suffer for the sake of Christ..." when Moses lived more than 1,000 years before Jesus?
6. Pastor Brian described faith as "the orientation of the soul toward the invisible God." What does it look like to orient one's soul toward God?
7. What price did Moses have to pay for rejecting his Egyptian identity in order to identify with the people of God?
8. How do we keep our eyes on Jesus while we are in the process of making a daring move by faith?
9. Do you feel God calling you to make some kind of move that will require faith like Moses?
10. What can you do this week to take new bold steps of faith?
