Wednesday, April 10 | Luke 23:39–43 | 11th Station of the Cross: Jesus and the two thieves

Thursday, April 11 | John 19:25–27 | 12th Station of the Cross: Jesus gives his mother to John

Friday, April 12 | Luke 23:44–46 | 13th Station of the Cross: Jesus dies

Saturday, April 13 | John 19:38–42 | 14th Station of the Cross: Jesus is buried

Palm Sunday, April 14 | Luke 19:28–40 | Jesus makes his triumphal entry

Holy Monday, April 15 | Mark 11:12–23 | Jesus cleanses the temple

Holy Tuesday, April 16 | Luke 21:5–33 | Jesus gives the Olivet Discourse

Holy Wednesday, April 17 | Mark 14:1–11 | Jesus is anointed in Bethany
